

# Bethany Land Institute holds third family day

On Monday, July 29, 2024, Bethany Land Institute (BLI) celebrated its third family day at the institute's campus in Nandere, Kasana-Luweero Diocese. The event commenced with a Holy Mass led by Rt. Rev. Lawrence Mukasa, Bishop of Kasana-Luweero Diocese.

In his homily, Bishop Mukasa condemned what he described as selective and discriminatory evictions of people who had encroached on wetlands. The National Environment and Management Authority (NEMA) has recently carried out forced evictions in the Lubigi wetland area, demolishing numerous homes and businesses to restore wetlands essential for environmental conservation and reducing flood risks in Kampala and surrounding districts.

These evictions have sparked widespread criticism and concern. President Yoweri Museveni has declared that those evicted will not be compensated, citing the significant environmental damage. He argues that compensating the evictees would encourage further encroachment and indiscipline.

Human rights defenders have criticized the forceful evictions, noting that many affected are low-income urban residents with limited options. They claim that NEMA did not follow necessary legal procedures and disproportionately targeted the properties of the poor while sparing those of the wealthy. Despite these critiques, NEMA insists that the evictions are legally justified and necessary for environmental protection, pointing out that many of the evictees' land titles are irregular and that the law mandates the conservation of wetlands, even if it requires relocating inhabited communities.

While acknowledging the importance of conserving wetlands, Bishop Mukasa

emphasized the unfairness of the evictions. He highlighted that minor offenders are targeted while significant ones are overlooked, advocating for a more equitable approach. He questioned the involvement of local officials, pointing out their lack of proactive measures to prevent settlements in the wetlands. Bishop Mukasa stressed that the evictions have left the underprivileged even poorer, underscoring the broader implications of poverty and environmental degradation. He proposed coffee farming as an alternative to alleviate poverty, suggesting that with the right support, families could transition from vulnerable encroachers to productive farmers, benefiting both the economy and the environment.

## Bishop Mukasa Praises BLI

The bishop commended BLI, describing it as a response to Pope Francis' call to restore nature. "All of us should be sons and daughters of Laudato Si'," he said, referring to the 2015 encyclical by Pope Francis that urges humanity to care for the environment and addresses the interconnectedness of social justice and environmental stewardship. Bishop Mukasa also encouraged BLI management to expand its goals throughout the diocese.

## Post-Mass Activities

After Mass, Rev. Fr. Mathias Jjooga, Parish Priest of Our Lady of Grace Nandere, called for support for the ongoing preparations for the Parish's "quasquicentennial" on December 8, 2024, marking its 125th anniversary since its creation in 1899.

During the same Family Day, over 20 caretaker leaders were commissioned. Sandra Kaitesi, speaking on behalf of the leaders, said, "We are caretaker

leaders in integral ecology," and emphasized their commitment to environmental conservation.

Rev. Fr. Emmanuel Katongole, President of BLI, announced the launch of a pastoral formation program for all religious men and women this year. Fr. Cornelius Sempala, a co-founder of BLI and site manager, recalled that Bishop Paul Ssemogerere, now Archbishop of Kampala Archdiocese, had envisioned Kasana-Luweero Diocese as a model in integral ecology.

## Alumni Association Launch

An alumni association for BLI was also launched during the event, with Fr. Frank Mugga as its President and a six-member committee. Fr. Mugga pledged that the association would organize next year's family day with assistance from Fr. Joseph Kakooza Nnyanzi, the Administrator.

## A Brief History of BLI's Founding

BLI was founded by three priests and friends—Father Emmanuel Katongole, Father Cornelius Sempala, and Father Anthony Zachary Rweza—in response to the challenges of poverty, food insecurity, environmental degradation, and youth unemployment. In 2019, the Diocese of Kasana-Luweero became a co-founding partner through a memorandum of understanding, which included leasing land at Nandere Parish, home to the only natural forest left in Luweero District. Bishop Paul Ssemogerere became a founding partner and patron of BLI. The founders, all Ugandans, have leveraged their studies and international experiences to address the challenges and opportunities in Uganda. BLI was formally launched in 2022.

# High Primary School Dropout Rate Endangers Future Workforce

Educators have warned that the country's chronically high primary school dropout rate after, or even before, completing P.7 endangers tomorrow's workforce.

According to an analysis of figures from assessment body Uganda National Examinations Board (Uneb) and Education and Sports Sector Annual Performance Reports (ESSAPRs), the latest data on the dropout rate of Primary Seven (P.7) pupils in Uganda indicates that approximately 42.8% of pupils who start primary school do not complete P.7.

This statistic means that almost 43 out of every 100 pupils drop out before finishing primary school.

The dropout rate is particularly concerning for girls, with 46.4% of female pupils dropping out before completing P.7, compared to 44.2% for boys.

This gender disparity highlights the additional challenges girls face in continuing their education, such as early marriage and childbearing, which often interrupt their schooling.

Rev. Fr. Akello Ronald, Chairman of the Association of Catholic Education Institutions (ACEI), spoke as the Guest Speaker at the Kasana-Luweero Diocesan Teachers' Day celebrations on Friday, July 19, 2024, at the Luweero Teachers' SACCO gardens in Luweero town council. He expressed deep concern about the high dropout rate of children before and after completing Primary 7.

He revealed that he and others were called to a meeting with President Museveni and first lady Janet Museveni, who also serves as the minister for

education and sports. The meeting focused on school enrollment.

According to Fr. Okello, the huge gap in the transition from primary to secondary school is cause for alarm.

He warns that if we do not solve this issue, we risk losing a whole generation.

While increasing vocational training is desirable and vital for job development, Fr. Okello believes that secondary school is critical in developing and reinforcing children's academic foundations.

During the same festivities, Kasana-Luweero Diocesan Education Secretary Rev. Fr. Joseph Mary Ssekalegga urged parents to make sure they save money for their children's education so they don't drop out too early. For teachers, he suggested using social media as a

dependable and contemporary form of communication.

According to Fr. Ssekalegga, apps like WhatsApp have transformed communication.

He claims that by forming groups, teachers may interact instantaneously, rendering traditional letter-writing and delivery techniques obsolete.

He believes that instructors must embrace new technology in order to collaborate effectively.

Fr. Ssekalegga stressed the importance of teachers using current communication technologies to improve their cooperation and efficiency in today's fast-paced society.

However, he warned them against abusing social media networks.

# CARITAS STAFF MEMBER PASSES AWAY

A somber mood enveloped the staff of Kasana-Luweero Diocese following the death of Mr. Thomas Orena, who was affiliated with Caritas Kasanaensis. Orena passed away on Saturday, July 21, 2024.

Paul Ssekajoko, a colleague of the deceased, shared the heartbreaking news on the Kasana-Luweero Diocese Staff Association (KALUDISA) WhatsApp group. "Hello team... With deep sorrow I inform you of the passing on of our brother Thomas...we have lost him. MHSRIP," he said.

Fr. Kasigwa Cyril, the Chancellor, expressed his condolences: "Sad news, dear colleagues. May Heaven receive him and may the Lord console his family, relatives, and friends." Evelyn Akampurira, another colleague,

mourned the loss: "So sad, bannange, may his soul rest in peace."

Ssekajoko eulogized Orena with heartfelt words: "Dear Thomas, a self-made man's journey never truly concludes. It morphs into a legacy that inspires generations to come. The conclusion is the epic tale told and retold, the testament to the indomitable spirit, and the spark that ignites greatness in others."

He continued: "The self-made journey reaches its zenith in the climax, where triumph reigns supreme. It is the moment of realization, the culmination of years of relentless pursuit. Climaxes are the monuments they build, the summits they conquer, and the dreams they manifest. It is the reward for their unwavering dedication."

"In conclusion, self-made men are the architects of their own destinies, crafting their stories with character, embracing challenges, conquering conflicts, reaching climaxes, and leaving behind enduring legacies. They are the embodiment of masculine virtue, and their tales resonate with the very essence of manhood," Ssekajoko added.

"Dear Thomas Orena, you might be dead, but you're still alive in our hearts forever. REST WITH THE ANGELS, MY BROTHER," he concluded.

Orena was laid to rest on Tuesday, July 23, 2024, at 3:00 PM in Serere District. He served as a Project Coordinator for the GCCA+ and NET projects, having joined Caritas in December 2020 and dedicated three and a half years to the organization.

# Lack of Chapel hinders formation at St. Kizito Minor Seminary

The Rector of St. Kizito Minor Seminary, Nandere, in the Diocese of Kasana-Luweero, Rev. Fr. Peter Kisamba Mugerwa stated that the lack of a spacious chapel at the seminary is impeding the training of future priests.

The pioneer Bishop of Kasana-Luweero Diocese, Rt. Rev. Dr. Cyprian Kizito Lwanga, opened St. Kizito Minor Seminary in Nandere in 2001.

Initially, due to a small number of seminarians, a tiny chapel was built to accommodate not more than 50 individuals.

However, over time, the number of seminarians has risen to more than 250. According to Fr. Kisamba, this challenge has a significant impact on the seminarians' spiritual and educational development.

"We are currently holding prayers in the dining hall, which is unsuitable for worship. During prayers, the clattering of spoons and plates can be distracting and interferes with the sanctity of the Mass," Fr. Kisamba said.

He described the seminary as a beacon of Christ-centered education, emphasizing that the lack of a dedicated chapel is a serious concern because it is a critical component of a spiritual institution.

"Everything we do at the seminary is Christ-centered, and the church is the most essential structure at the seminary," he asserted.

Speaking at the seminary's 23rd-anniversary festivities on Saturday, July 13, 2024, Fr. Kisamba stated that they urgently need over 1 billion shillings to build a large chapel that can accommodate hundreds of seminarians.

They hope to complete the project by June 30th, 2026, in time for the seminary's 25th anniversary.

In addition to the church, Fr. Kisamba believes the seminary requires a library, a science laboratory, and a Mother Mary grotto.

He also mentioned the need to erect a statue of the seminary's patron, St. Kizito.

These facilities, according to Fr. Kisamba, are critical for the seminarians' holistic formation, combining spiritual growth with scholastic success.

## Post-Mass Activities

After Mass, a fundraising event was held for the construction of the new Seminary Chapel. Over 21 million shillings were collected, with 7 million shillings in cash and 14 million shillings in pledges. Prince Paul Kyabaggu, the Chairman of the Consultative Board for the Seminary, pledged 10 million shillings.

## Board Chair Requests to Step Down

Delivering his speech, the Chairman of the Consultative Board, Prince P. Kyabaggu, who has been at the helm of the board for a long time, requested to step down. He revealed that he is also too sickly to effectively do the job. He has been quite outstanding in contributing towards the development of the seminary over the years.






